The object of the year 2004: A strongroom of huge dimensions made of CEN VIII modules in mixed design and construction for a British pharmaceutical group

A strongroom for a British pharmaceutical group, made of CEN VIII modules in mixed design and construction featuring huge dimensions:

- a height of 9.50 m, a width of 13.40 m, a length of 23.00 m, a weight of approx. 350 tons
- and with 940 m<sup>2</sup> of modular walls
- a 4.40 m high and 2.50 wide strongroom door weighing 8.5 tons
- an electrically movable lattice day door

- an emergency door with electronic emergency unlocking
- and the steel construction to be supplied.

Development, planning and logistics placed extremely high demands on the engineering, all specialists and members of staff involved.
